## **School information**

St Mary's & St Peter's Catholic Primary School is a 1-form entry school situated in the BD3 area of the city on the Leeds/Bradford "corridor". We are a very diverse community with over 65% of our children being of the Islamic faith. Our aim is to welcome everyone, recognising each individual as a unique gift from God no matter what their ethnicity or faith. We strive to live, work and play by Gospel values, creating a safe, happy atmosphere within which we are all encouraged to explore and develop to our full potential in the knowledge and understanding of God's love for us.

The school is of average size for a primary school (approximately 230 children including nursery). The proportion of pupils known to be eligible for free school meals is above average, and is currently around 37%. The number of pupils identified as having special educational needs is broadly average. The proportion of pupils who speak English as an additional language is very high. Just over half the pupils are from Pakistani heritage and a large number of ethnic groups are represented in the school. This includes pupils recently arrived in the country from Eastern Europe, Africa, Asia and India.

The school was last inspected in July 2016 and was judged as being a "Good" school.


